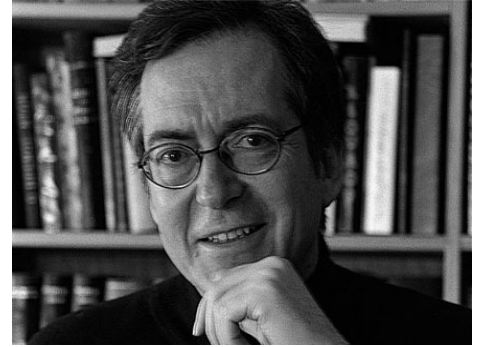

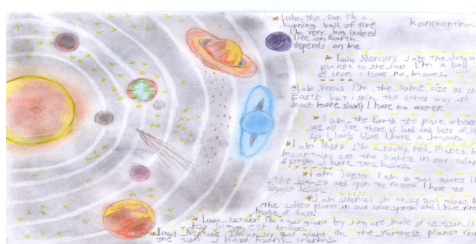

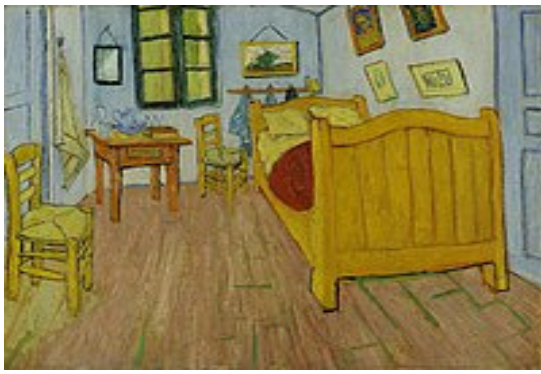
Vincent van Gogh is one of the most famous painters. He was born in Holland in 1853, in the nineteenth century. His real name was Vincent fan Hoh. As a child, he was very serious. He started drawing early in his childhood with the help of his mother. His father worked as a vicar.

At the beginning, he worked as an art dealer. During his life, he also worked in the church and as a teacher. He lived in Holland, in London, in Belgium and in France, where he made some of his most beautiful paintings. When living in Holland he used to paint with dark and gloomy colors.

Van Gogh went to Paris in 1886 and then he started using lighter bright colors. He used brushwork technique. Some of his most beautiful paintings were drawn when he lived in Arles.

For some time, he was friend with Paul Gauguin who was a famous artist too. He wanted to open an art gallery with his friend but when his friend refused, he threatened to kill him. Later he regretted it, he cut his ear and he went to the hospital for mentally ill people. Then he made a portrait of himself with his injured ear.

During his life, he was very unhappy and poor and he sold only one painting. He became famous after his death. Some of his most famous paintings are: The Starry Night, the Sunflowers, the Irises, self-portraits and paintings with Cypressess.

He killed himself in 1890. Today there is a museum in Amsterdam with Van Gogh's paintings, but some other important paintings are in other big museums

Vincent van Gogh was born in Xroouz Zider on 30 March in 1853. His father was a pastor. His brother died on the birth. His mother was stressed if her son will survive. When he was a child he was lonely and confused. He loved

painting and drawing. The only person being who supported him was his younger brother Theo. While the whole family turned him down.

After school he went to boarding school. In 1866 he decided to stop school in the 2 grade of the high school. In 1869 he moved in Gooplin in Hague. In 1873 he went to London and loved a woman who was secretly engaged and she turned him down. He decided to dedicate to others so he read the Holly bible. In 1875 he worked at the headquarters of gallery Goupil. He used to send letters to his brother Theo and he wrote everything that was happening, so Theo encouraged him to start painting. In 1876 he went to England to teach lessons in a school. In 1878 he stayed for Christmas in his parent's house.

His family gave him the means to attended courses in the theological school. In the entrance exam he failed. He decided to work as a pastor. He donated to give his things to people who were less fortunate. He went to Borinaz to communities of coal miners. Their ecclesiastical authorities are obliged to leave Belgium. Escaping in 1880 also abandoned the pastor's life. When he was 27 years old he was unemployed. He decided to watch lessons next to his cousin Anton Mauve. In his cousin's studio he took his first steps. His relationship with his cousin leads he couldn't complete anything. He loved an artist called Remprant. He was painting days and nights.

In 1885 he saw lessons in academy Ambersas he was quickly dismissed by the Academy professor. He used the Japanese art. He liked the Japanese art. He worked with pencil, pen,

coal and watercolor. In 1886 he went to Paris. He lived with Theo. Theo and Van Gogh moved to a house in Monmarti. He met Pissarro, Degas, Toulouse-Lautrec and Gauguin. Every day he was going on a cafe in Paris. He wasn't giving money but he gave them pieces of his artwork. The cafe closed and the pieces of art was in the police. Barba-Tangy gave him the colors to paint his arts. In 1888 he went to Arles. In Arles he painted the trees, the city and the people.

He lived to the yellow-house. He was happy and put colors in his artworks. In 1888 he sold «The red vineyard». Van Gogh met Gauguin and lived together in Arles. He was happy with Gauguin. Gauguin thought that Van Gogh it owed many. One night attacked to Gauguin with a razor. At the last moment he feels ill and he cut a part of his ear. From his fats he committed suicide. In his funeral came three people.

Family

Vincent van Gogh was born on March 30, 1853, in Groot-Zundert, Netherlands. Vincent van Gogh's father, Theodorus van Gogh, was an austere country minister, and his mother, Anna Cornelia Carpentus, was a moody artist whose love of nature and drawing was transferred to her son.

He was not the first child of Theodorus van Gogh and Anna Carpentus: another son (also named Vincent) had been still born on the same date, precisely one year earlier. Happily, the birth of the second Vincent went smoothly, and was followed by three sisters and two brothers: Anna, Theo, Wil, Lies and Cor. Born into an upper-middle-class family, Van Gogh was a serious, quiet and thoughtful child.

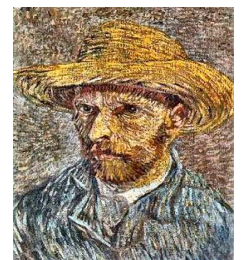
As a young man he worked as an art dealer, often travelling, but became depressed after he was moved to London. He turned to religion, and spent time as a Protestant missionary in southern Belgium. He suffered from depression and solitude before starting painting in 1881,

having moved back home with his parents. His younger brother Theo supported him financially, and the two kept communicating for a long time with letters.

In 1886, he moved to Paris, where he met members of the *avant-garde*, including Émile Bernard and Paul Gauguin, who were reacting against the Impressionist sensibility.

As his work developed he created a new approach to still life and local landscapes. His paintings were brighter in color as he developed a style that became fully realized during his stay in Arles in the south of France in 1888.

During this period his paintings subjects also included series of olive trees, wheat fields and sunflowers.



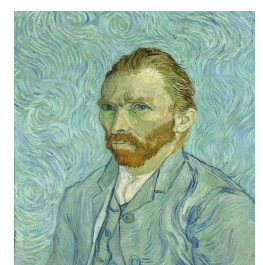
Van Gogh the Artist

He was a Post-Impressionist painter who is among the most famous figures in the history of Western art. In about ten years he created about 2,100 artworks, including around 860 oil paintings, most of them in the last two years of his life. They include landscapes, still lifes, portraits and self-portraits, and their characteristics are the bold and dramatic colors.

In July 27, 1890, Vincent van Gogh went out to paint in the morning carrying a loaded pistol and shot himself in the chest, but the bullet did not kill him. He was found bleeding in his room.

Vincent Van Gogh had made a lot of paintings some of which are : «the sunflowers».

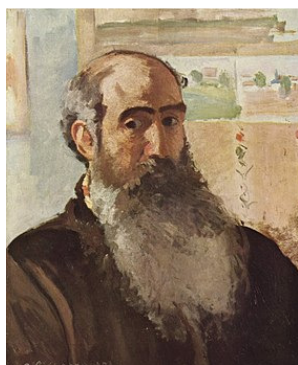

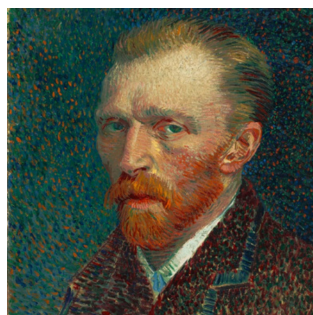

In 1888 Van Gogh had a big fight with his friend Paul and Van Gogh tried to kill him. He felt deeply remorseful afterwards so he cut his ear and 2 days later he died. After his death he became famous and the people made many exhibitions with his art. Some of them are: in Paris in 1901, in Amsterdam in 1905, in New York in 1913, in Berlin in 1914 and in Greece in 2018. He created 2100 art works. Vincent Willem Van Gogh made 1200 paintings, including around 860 oil paintings most of them in the last two years of his life.

VINCENT VAN GOGH (1853-1890)

Vincent van Gogh was born in 1853 in Zundert in southern Netherlands. He died in 1890 in Auberge Ravoux. His father and grandfather were miner, but others in his family worked in art world. Vincent had two brothers and three sisters. He was closest to his younger brother Theo.

He loved his first cousin. He wrote letters to his brother who helped him. He sended 700 letters to his brother. Between 1869-1876 he worked for an international art dealing firm.

In 1880,at the age of 27,he decided to become an artist. In 1886 went to Paris and met many artists including Degas,Toulouse-Lautrec,Pissarro and Gauguin.



In 1888, Van Gogh moved to Provence in southern France, where he painted his famous series 'Sunflowers'. He invited Gauguin to join him but they soon began to quarrel and one night, Van Gogh threatened Gauguin with a razor. Deeply remorseful he then cut off part of his own ear.

On 27 July 1890, suffering from depression, Van Gogh shot himself. He died two days later.

He created many paintings in few years (3.000 art fairs!!!!!!!).

With this works he wanted to show us his feelings. He sold only one art of all. Some of his famous works are Starry Night, The Bedroom, Irises, Sunflowers and The Potato Eaters. His style was a post impressionist and modern.

Although he enjoyed drawing from the time he was young boy, Vincet had a number of other jobs before he decided to work as an artist full time. He worked as a teacher in London and then as a miner. He also worked in a book store, an art gallery, and as a missionary.



Although he wasn't famous during his lifetime, today he is considerent one of greatest and most influential artists of his time. Many of his paintings sell for million of dollars today. There are over 800 surviving oil painting as well as over thousand water colors and sketches of his work.



One of the most famous paintings is Thatched Cottages in Cordeville despite the idyllic motif of the old, that shed roofs of the farm houses with vegetable garden, fence and wall, a great unrest is diffused over the whole of the painting by the bushes and dark trees.

Vincent Van Gogh is one of the most famous painters. He was born on 30 March 1853 in Zundert, in the southern Netherlands. His father was a pastor.

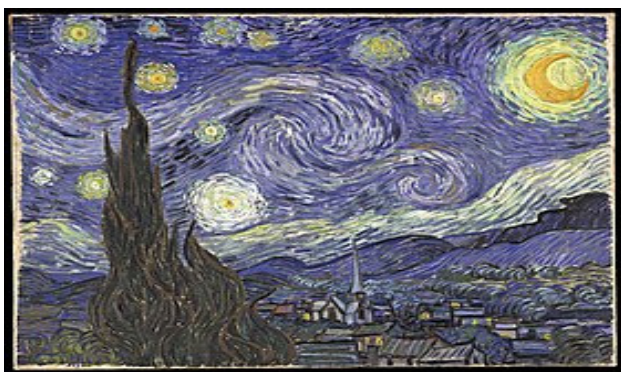
He began to write letters to his younger brother Theo in 1869. Van Gogh's job took him to London and to Paris, but he was not interested in the work and was dismissed in 1876. He became a teacher in England and then a preacher in Belgium. In 1880 at the age of 27, he decided to become an artist. Van Gogh moved around, teaching himself to draw and paint. In 1886 he went to Theo in Paris and he met many artists. In 1888 Van Gogh moved to Provence in southern France, where he painted his famous series Sunflowers. This was the only painting that he had sold when he was in life.

Some years later he cut off a part of his own ear, this was the first sign of his mental health problems.

He died on July 29, 1890 in Auvers in France at the age of 37.

Van Gogh painted 3.000 series. One of his most famous works is Starry Night, that you can see it at New York Museum of Modern Art.

The last part of our tour of the exhibition was a huge room with interactive walls where the artist's biography and stories of his life were projected in images, with descriptions in writing.

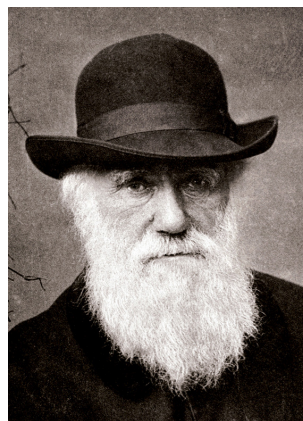
This was different, unique and we learned many things about Vincent Van Gogh in an interesting way.

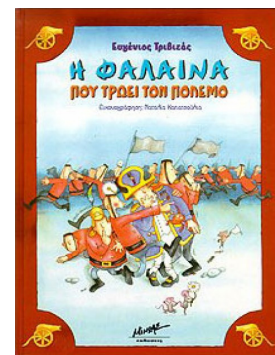
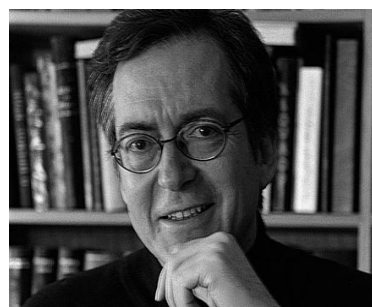

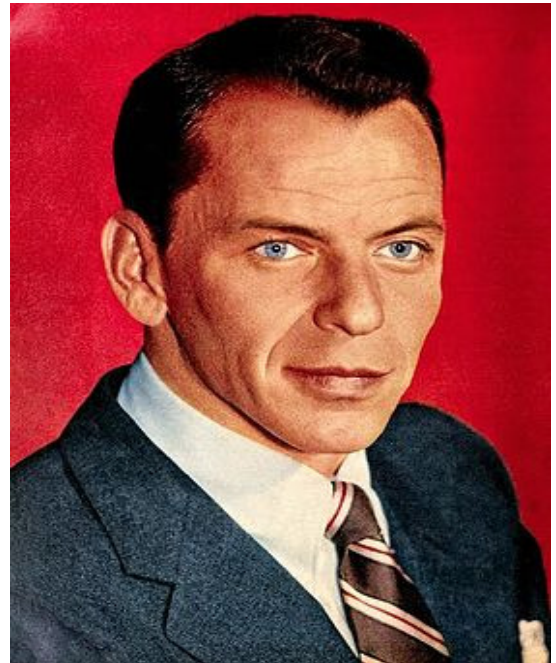
Jon Bon Jovi
